Squad size	Team of 3 for each of the above categories.	
Gender	As identified in the above category.	
Eligibility	No restrictions beyond age and gender criteria.	
Basic Rules	 Each runner will have a copy of the course map to enable them to contribute fully to their team. An electronic punching system will be used with an electronic cad for each team member. The event time for each category will be no greater than 20 minutes. Team members must stay together during the course of the event and must punch all controls and the finish within 1 minute of each other. Year 5/6 girls teams will start first at 11am, with the warning system at 11.15am. Finish 11.20am. Year 5/6 boys teams will start at 11.30am with the warning signal at 11.45am. Finish 11.50am. Year 7 girls teams will start at 12pm, with the warning signal at 12.15pm. Finish 12.20pm. Year 7 boys teams will at 12.30pm, with the warning signal at 12.45pm. Finish 12.50pm. The warning signal for the start and at 5 minutes left will be an airhorn. Scoring System – 10 points for every control visited, but minus 10 points for every minute or part minute late.
