| Basic Rules | Each team member takes part in every event: <br> - Standing Long Jump <br> - Vortex Howler Throw <br> - 75 m Sprint <br> - 600 m Run <br> - For each event, each team member receives a score based on their performance (time/ distance etc) <br> - Each athlete has 3 attempts at the jump and throw activities, with their best score counting <br> - There is 1 attempt at the run (however there can be up to 3 attempts if time allows) <br> - There is a team relay race at the end of the event (only if time allows) <br> - Team member points are added together and an aggregate score is worked out <br> - In teams of 10, the top 8 scorers in each event count towards the total team score. <br> Full rules will be posted onto the School Games webpage <br> Schools will be required to submit an electronic declaration sheet to their School Games Organiser at least 7 days prior to the Festival |
