## Cheshire \& Warrington School Games Festival Mini Red Tennis - Team Event

| KEY INFORMA | TION |
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| Age Category | Year 3\&4 |
| Squad size | Team will be made up of four players |
| Gender | Minimum of two boys and two girls |
| Eligibility | Team will be made up of two boys and two girls from years 3 and / or 4 <br> - Both club and non-club tennis players are eligible to enter <br> - Teams will be split into groups <br> - Teams will play against all other teams in their group, with the winning team from each group playing off in a final, to determine the overall winner <br> - Each team is asked to nominate 'Boy 1', 'Boy 2', 'Girl 1' and 'Girl 2'. In each match, players will play against their opposite player |
| Basic Rules | Matches <br> - Mini Tennis scoring does not use traditional tennis scoring (15, 30, 40 etc). Instead, simple numbered scoring is used, i.e. 1, 2, 3, 4 etc <br> - Matches will take place on a quarter of a full tennis court <br> - Matches will be 'timed', so play starts and finishes on the sound of the whistle <br> - Matches will be up to ten minutes in length (Times of matches may be reduced due to extenuating circumstances e.g. bad weather or event over running. This is at the referees discretion) <br> - Each 'match' is set off to play and the final score is recorded. All of the points from the matches are added together to come up with a cumulative team score. Wins and losses are not recorded <br> - Only players, competition staff and 1 member of staff from each school (if needed) are allowed on court during play <br> - The Tournament Referees decision is final <br> Playing <br> - The serve is decided by a 'toss' at the start of the match <br> - The nominated person serves for the first point, it then alternates every 2 points <br> - When serving, players should stand behind the baseline <br> - When serving, the ball must not be bounced before being hit <br> - The serve can be hit over or under arm <br> - Serves should be hit diagonallv, landing in the diagonallv opposite service box |

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## Playing

- The serve is decided by a 'toss' at the start of the match
- The nominated person serves for the first point, it then alternates every 2 points
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- When serving, the ball must not be bounced before being hit
- The serve can be hit over or under arm
- Serves should be hit diagonally, landing in the diagonally opposite service box
- Each court will have a scorer, who calls out the scores and helps out with decisions
- Felt Mini Tennis Red Balls will be used for all matches
- Matches will take place outdoors
- Rackets no longer than $23^{\prime \prime}$ in length should be used
